GUIDELINES FOR PREPARATION OF ABSTRACTS

- i. The abstract must report original research, protocols of original research, systematic reviews or meta-analyses, not previously published elsewhere.
- ii. The abstracts should be in English, coherent and free of language errors.
- iii. The title should be brief and in capitals, and reflect the study reported.
- iv. The name with initials and designations of all authors, the place (or places) where the research work was conducted should be stated. The name of the author who will present the paper should be underlined. Do not use prefixes such as Dr., Prof., Mr., Ms., etc. Do not include qualifications here.
- v. The text of the abstract should not exceed 300 words excluding title, author affiliations, acknowledgements, key words and references. The abstract must be structured as Introduction, Methods, Results and Conclusions.
- vi. The body of the text should be typed in Times New Roman (font size 11). Use Arabic numerals and SI units throughout. The abstract should describe original work, and indicate the purpose of the study, methods and materials used, statistical methods employed and results obtained. Statements such as “conclusions will be discussed at the session” are unacceptable.
- vii. A maximum of five keywords should be provided.
- viii. All authors should give written consent for the abstract.
- ix. Acknowledgements should be restricted to the names of funding agencies providing sponsorship.
- x. During submission, in addition to entering your abstract in the given template, a PDF version of your abstract should be attached (should not contain author details), along with the duly signed consent form.

Please note:

1. All correspondence will be addressed to the corresponding author.
2. In the event that the presenter indicated in the application is unable to present the paper, it is the responsibility of the corresponding author either to withdraw the paper in advance or arrange for one of the co-authors to present the paper. In the event that the abstract is not presented, the abstract will be withdrawn from the final abstract book, and all co-authors will be notified.
3. Ethical considerations - where applicable, the Ethics Review Committee number should be provided during submission. For clinical trials, the clinical trials registry number should be submitted.
4. The Editorial Committee has the right to reject the abstracts not conforming to these requirements.

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ORAL/ POSTER PRESENTATIONS

- Abstracts will be accepted for oral and poster presentation.
- All abstracts, regardless of their presentation method, are subject to the same rules for submission and presentation.
- An individual cannot submit the same material for two different presentation modes. Please do not submit the same abstract multiple times.

- The SAAP editorial committee shall have full authority to accept or to reject a paper upon evaluation of the title and the abstract. Rejection of a paper by the editorial committee is final.
- Accepted abstracts will be organized by the SAAP committee into working group subject matter based on originality and relevance to the theme of scientific session of the conference.
- Abstract submissions accepted by the SAAP Committee will be published in the conference proceedings only if the presenting author is registered and paid in full by 15th September 2022.
- Presentations must be made in English, as no translation service will be available.
